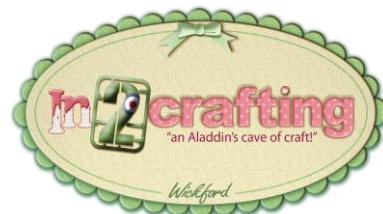

Workshop List for January to March 2012

Happy New Year to all and many thanks for your support and custom over what was a long and difficult time for retail in 2011. Here is our new list of workshops with lots to inspire and motivate you. As before, we will be taking £2.50 off your shopping of £5 or more on the day of your class if you've had to pay to park in the main car park (this covers 4 hours), as well as giving you privilege points and workshop discount too! This parking refund excludes Saturdays, as the main car park (nearest us) is free all day (please don't use The Co-Op as theirs is only free for 1½ hours). Booking will begin straight away, so best book early as places have been going very fast!!!

Time : Please check individual workshops for correct times – last 2½ hours.

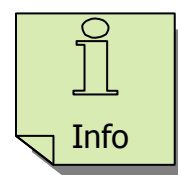
Price : All sessions are £10.00 with refreshments included unless stated.

There's no need to bring any tools or materials, it's all provided for you to make your cards, usually 3 or more depending on the session.

Payment for sessions to be paid at time of booking please. Alternatively, you can phone and book into the diary with payment being made by credit/debit card, or of course a cheque can still be put in the post which will confirm your place (with 2 weeks' notice). Due to the popularity of some sessions, we may not be able to hold your place unless payment is received to confirm your booking. (Cheques made payable to "In2crafting"). Any cancellations made less than a week prior to the workshop will not be reimbursed if we cannot fill the place. Booking will start straight away so it's best to book as early as possible. As some sessions become full very quickly, it is always advisable to leave your name and phone number, because if someone cannot make it, we can phone our reserve list or even add another session if demand is there. You will be able to save on purchases made on the day of your workshop by using your **customer privilege card** to accumulate points **plus an extra 5% discount**. (See back page for more details). For those without a card you can still save 10% on the day.

Don't forget, if you are unsure about what's involved in any of the sessions, please ask and I'll be happy to explain what we will be covering on the day.
